CARE OF THE WORKING ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Stower Vale Pre-School recognizes the contribution a clean, orderly, well maintained and attractive environment makes to the quality of the care and learning it provides for children. To achieve this, time and effort will be invested in maintaining the quality of the building and the outdoor areas, and providing high quality resources for the children to use.

There is an expectation that all adults involved with the setting will contribute to this process by maintaining the cleanliness and tidiness of the communal areas of the setting. They will act as good role models to the children at all times by respecting and caring for the resources and equipment that have been provided in the setting and by ensuring that it is always used correctly. Toys and resources will be kept clean by following cleaning procedures and any damaged or broken items will be removed immediately for repair or disposal.

All members of staff are expected to be vigilant and proactive in contributing to the daily maintenance of the setting – by cleaning areas after use, helping children to put resources away tidily, storing clothing and shoes in an orderly manner, emptying waste bins and keeping all toilet areas clean and hygienic.
